





IPB internationalization in numbers:

- ✓ The IPB implements mobility within the European Higher Education Area for over 20 years: more than 200 bilateral agreements with HEIs from 24 different European Countries
- ✓ 1,1 M€ Erasmus budget for student and staff mobility within European Union and with Partner Countries
- ✓ Expansion of the international cooperation outside Europe: more than 150 cooperation agreements with non-European HEIs (26 Countries)
- ✓ 900 Students under international mobility per year (incoming and outgoing Erasmus and non-EU students)

- ✓ 25% of the IPB graduates had an international mobility experience during their study programme (*Europe 2020 target: 20%*)




Teaching Crossroads at the IPB Repository: Since 2012, 5 Editions more than **11** thousand downloads
