ABOUT ICM

The major aim of the International Credit Mobility (ICM) project is the consolidation of the ongoing cooperation between the Polytechnic Institute of Bragança (IPB, Portugal, www.ipb.pt/en) and the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) outside European Union, particularly to promote student mobility for double diploma and staff development on the European Higher Education best-practices, and to improve the management and operation of partner HEIs in international relations capacities.

WHY DOUBLE DIPLOMA?

Double diploma promotes more than just student mobility. It enhances a deeper cooperation between partner HEIs at both education and research levels and the share of the best-practices in international mobility and credit recognition.



The IPB has an internationalization programme with widely recognized success, including the annual mobility flow of 900 students and 300 teaching and non-teaching staff members, as a result of the cooperation with several European and non-European HEIs (www.ipb.pt/iro). Taking into account its dimension (7000 students and 400 teachers), these results place IPB in the first line of the international mobility.

The IPB is awarded with both the ECTS and the DS Labels, assuring the quality and the transparency of the students and staff mobility management and the fair academic and professional recognition of its

qualifications (www.ipb.pt/ectsguide and www.ipb.pt/sd).

The IPB has indicators of the impact and excellence of its scientific production and applied research in several areas. According to the SIR World Ranking 2016, the IPB is the Portuguese HEI with the best normalized impact, excellence rates and technological impact (www.scimagoir.com).

The fourth edition of the international ranking U-Multirank placed once more the IPB as the best within the Portuguese Universities of Applied Sciences system (www.u-multirank.eu)

IPB takes part of the Erasmus+ "NOW Portugal Consortium - Internships for Employability", representing the entire Portuguese North Region and enhancing the employability of graduates (www.nowportugal.pt).

The IPB offers bachelors and master programmes fully lectured in English (www.ipb.pt/admissions). This offer is being used to attract international students from all over the World and to promote double diploma projects with EU and non-EU HEIs.

IPB is a multicultural institution, where 20% of its students are international students.



STUDENT MOBILITY

The ICM project foresees international student mobility for double diploma (DD) programmes between the IPB and the Partner HEIs. The European HE best-practices are used to prepare and monitor student mobility.

Before mobility

Partner HEIs select the students according to a transparent and documented process, following the prerequisites agreed by both institutions.

Students should:

a) be enrolled in the sending HEI in the area and study cycle defined in the agreement;

b) have finished the number of curricular years **During mobility** and credits requested for DD mobility;

c) be proficient in Portuguese or English (B2 level).

The student curriculum, the academic record, and the motivation for mobility are valued in the selection process. Students from disadvantaged backgrounds or with special needs are encouraged to participate.

After selection of students, the learning agreements are signed by students and both HEIs. For DD master projects, the research work plan and the supervisors at both HEIs are defined.

The ICM students arrive at the IPB for a mobility period of at least 10 months and following the signed learning agreements. For master DD, a final public defence will occur at IPB by the end of the mobility period.

The transcript of records is issued, guaranteeing the recognition at the home institution of all credits completed at IPB. For DD, IPB will issue the Portuguese diploma after the student successfully completes the mobility programme.
