IPB ICM history and impact. Global models for double diploma and research cooperation. Tuesday, May 14th, 14:30, ESTiG Library

An overview of the IPB double diploma international platform within the Erasmus International Credit Mobility (ICM) action: the partners, the degree programmes, the fluxes. WHY double diploma? Impact for students, teachers, researchers and institutions. And HOW? The foundations of the Bologna spirit: transparent, flexible and strategic recognition of credits and competences. Flexible global models for double diploma involving bachelor and master programmes. Double diploma as a unique opportunity for research cooperation.

Double diploma opportunities and results: parallel meetings with IPB course directors and head of departments. Wednesday, May 15th, 14:30

IPB course directors, head of departments and researchers will meet ICM partners' representatives, according to their profiles ("Group"). IPB will present the study plans of the bachelor and master programmes used in double diploma student mobility, and the interests in research cooperation. The workshop will address the double diploma models with ICM partners and the co-supervision of master dissertations of ICM students as a unique opportunity for research cooperation.
