



The relevance of the internationalization strategy at the Primorskaya State Academy of Agriculture, RF

Since 2016 our academy has been participating in the new Erasmus+ program, within the framework of the International Credit Mobility project, which provides scholarships to undergraduates from the Forestry Institute of Primorskaya State Academy of Agriculture to study at the Polytechnic Institute of Bragança (Portugal) and which increases the opportunities for academic mobility of students, undergraduates, graduate students and teachers, as well as strengthening the cooperation of Primorskaya State Academy of Agriculture with the world's leading universities.

The student's credit mobility is important not only from the point of view of developing and improving the learning opportunities in foreign universities, but also from the point of view of the development of our academy, in which mobility becomes an incentive for comparing and updating training programs, improving the quality of teaching, and improving the activities of international and student services.

Mobility is useful not only for students, but also for the quality of education in general, as it contributes to the development of an internationalization strategy and has a positive impact on the training system in our academy.
